RISING MOON was unhurried for a half, angled three wide while rallying on the turn, charged to the front inside the furlong marker and drew off under mild encouragement. HONOUR DEVIL (ARG) raced inside for a half, split horses while gaining on the turn then finished willingly between rivals to gain the place. TIMBER RESERVE pressed the pace from outside for six furlongs, lodged a mild bid in upper stretch and weakened late. COAL PLAY sprinted clear on the rail, shook loose in upper stretch and faltered late. HUNTING was outrun for a half, swung five wide between horses at the quarter pole and flattened out. TIZBIG checked at the start, rushed up three wide nearing the far turn, raced just off the pace three wide to the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. MINT LANE showed speed between horses for a half and gave way. FAMOUS PATRIOT raced wide and tired.
