Footnotes

NOBLE TUNE settled near the back of the pack, rated kindly while racing along the outside for nearly three-quarters, picked up interest coming to the five-sixteenths pole and was angled out sharply and with a good burst of speed to turn for home holding a slim advantage, drew out to a comfortable advantage during the run through the furlong grounds, fended off the runner up during the last eighth, under a much less than brisk hand ride. NOTACATBUTALLAMA contently tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, responded positively when given his cue for the stretch drive, altered course into the two path in upper stretch, altered course outward one additional path soon afterwards, failed to cut into the winner's margin but continued onward with good energy to procure the place. SPECIAL SKILLS quickly established control, proved ratable from the inside on a loosely-contested lead until the half mile pole, felt an increase in pressure as the two closest crept up, getting put to a stern test by both of them at the five-sixteenths marker, got let out in response to the challenge and rebuffed them only to have the top one zoom by in the four path at the quarter pole, weakened steadily from upper stretch to the wire. QUINZIEME MONARQUE outrun for six furlongs while racing along the outside, went on to improve position while never menacing. SAINT VIGEUR racing at a considerable distance from off the rail on the far turn, was put to a prolonged drive, spun four wide into the lane, had no rally. CERRO (IRE) patiently stalked SPECIAL SKILLS from off the inside down the backstretch, advanced in unison with WEST HILLS GIANT upon departing the backstretch, issued an abbreviated bid three wide past the midway point, flattened out. WEST HILLS GIANT was rated while accompanying the leader from the two path, got let out a notch and ranged up, with CERRO tagging along one path wider during the run around the second bid, challenged for a few strides wedged between opponents in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, failed to sustain the move and gave way.
