TEDDY'S PROMISE settled inside then off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging outside foes to gain the lead in deep stretch while bumping with RUMOR and was being straightened on the wire. RUMOR chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, rallied between foes past midstretch, bumped with the winner in late stretch and continued willingly. PINK LOLLIPOPS stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail on the turn, cut back to the fence into the stretch and finished with interest inside. DAWNIE MACHO sped to the early lead and crossed over, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the turn, inched away again a bit off the rail in midstretch and was outfinished between foes late. IZZY RULES was sent between horses then stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter on the turn, fell back some in the stretch, was in a bit tight off heels in deep stretch and weakened late. CANDY'S PLEASURE angled in early and saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back in the stretch and had little left for the drive.
