SMILING TIGER between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, swung out into the stretch, bid four wide past midstretch, gained the advantage a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed under some late urging. PRIVATE ZONE angled in and dueled between horses, fought back between foes in the stretch and held second. CAPITAL ACCOUNT broke slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and rallied late for the show. COMMA TO THE TOP broke slightly in the air and a bit slowly, stalked early then bid three deep on the backstretch and turn, put a head in front in midstretch, was between horses in deep stretch and was edged late for third. SMASH had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. BANK THE EIGHT chased outside the winner then a bit off the rail, dropped back and angled in on the turn and gave way.
