Footnotes

MEETYUATHEBRIG, reserved soon after the start while racing in behind the leaders, came out seven wide approaching the final quarter to commence his bid, reached the front just before the eighth pole, was roused once with the whip, then drew off the final sixteenth under mild hand urging. DREAM RUN, bumped from both sides at the start, went up soon after to vie for the lead from between rivals, gained a slim advantage, was headed nearing the end of the backstretch from the inside by FIRSTSTADEPOSIT, continued close up, gained even terms in the upper stretch, wasn't a match for the winner but clearly bested the rest. ONE BY THE KNOWS leaned in at the start bumping DREAM RUN, went up early to force the pace three abreast, battled on even terms into the upper stretch but weakened when the test came. SILVERTONGUE FOX quickly gained a position while working his way inward, tracked the leaders four or five wide, moved to a slight advantage right at the six-furlong call, then flattened out the final furlong. WEDLOCK, never far back while racing in behind the dueling leaders from early on, lacked room through the upper stretch, then, when clear, lacked a response. GIFT OF THE EAGLE came out at the break bumping DREAM RUN, was unhurried, made a bold run six wide nearing the final quarter but flattened out when straightened for the drive. AMERICAN CENTURY saved ground but failed to rally. GOLDEN TANGLE tired early. GAIL'S DRIVE wasn't a factor. RADICAL RILEY was outrun. FIRSTSTADEPOSIT broke sharply to gain the lead, was headed before going a quarter, regained a slight edge nearing the end of the backstretch, lost it on the turn, then gave way readily in the drive.
