After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since November 6 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade I or II stakes since September 7, 4 lbs.; \$60,000 in 2010, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, April 7, 2010 with 35 nominations.

ATTA BOY ROY sprinted clear and angled in to set a clear pace, widened his advantage entering the stretch, then was all out to keep the fast closing WARRIOR'S REWARD at bay. The latter was taken back at once under a hard hold, commenced his bid with three furlongs to run, advanced four wide through the turn, angled out further and split horses entering the stretch, came six wide, finished full of run and was getting to the winner with every stride. MUSKET MAN was allowed to settle, moved up four wide through the turn, was blocked nearing the furlong marker, altered course to the inside and was making up ground late. VENTANA broke a step slow, angled out and rushed to contention six wide, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. ACCREDIT attended the pace three wide, came four wide and loomed a danger entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. VICTORY NOTION was slow into stride, made a late rally circling eight wide and improved his position through the stretch. KENSEI was allowed to settle four wide, ranged into striking distance through the turn, shifted to the inside of ACCREDIT inside the furlong marker but lacked a response when asked.

HAMAZING DESTINY contended between horses to the stretch and faded. HULL failed to respond. COUNTRY DAY was forwardly placed off of the inside through the turn and dropped out. MUNNINGS showed little in a dull effort. WALL STREET WONDER chased ATTA BOY ROY to no avail along the inside, stopped leaving the turn, was eased to the wire but walked off.
