FOR FILLIES, TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$2,500 each (Stallion) ; \$3,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$3,000 to start. The added money together with all nomination fees, eligibility payments, entry and starting fees to be divided.

Approximately 66.5% of gross purse October 15 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Stallion and Breeders' Awards to be distributed according to Florida Statute in effect on the date of the race. Weight: 118 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Nominations for Stallions closed on February 15, 2008 with 116 Stallion Nominations. (No Supplementary Nominations). Closed Friday, May 20, 2011 with 442 nominations.

AWESOME BELLE set the pace along the inside into the stretch, then drew off roused. MACANUDA stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch but was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. REDBUD ROAD reserved while saving ground, swung out for the stretch run and closed to gain the show. DREAM POINT rated off the pace, saved ground and tired. SINISTER BREW raced with the early pace, was eased back leaving the first turn to stalk the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and faltered. QUEEN DRAMA stalked the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faded. THE WINNER IS was never a factor. ADELA'S SONG was outrun.
