EL ROMANO reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, then rallied to be just up at the wire. HERE WE GO JOE bumped with SUPERIORITY at the start, chased the pace along the rail, made a run to gain a slim lead in deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner at the wire. REX'S LAST TOUR tracked the pace, angled four wide for room on the turn, rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole but couldn't resist the top ones in the final strides. W. B. SMUDGE set the pace under pressure racing off the rail into the stretch, then tired. FORTUNATE BILL failed to menace after being outrun early. LITTLE NICHOLAS was no factor while racing four wide. SUPERIORITY bumped with HERE WE GO JOE at the start, then saved ground to no avail. TORMENTO was through early. RULE NUMBER SIX well placed early after hitting the gate at the start, tired. STAR DISTINCTION pressed the pace three wide to midway of the turn, then faded.
