COMMA TO THE TOP went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away into the stretch and drew off under a brisk hand ride and a long hold late. LIQUID ASSET had good early speed and dueled outside the winner, was no match for that one in the stretch and held second. RIDE CANDY RIDE chased inside, came out some a half mile out, continued inside on the turn, angled out into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. RED TESLA chased three deep then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out in the stretch and was edged for third. WHAT'S THE RUMPUS pulled a bit between horses early then chased just off the rail and lacked a rally in the stretch. DIME stalked outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. CELESTIC NIGHT saved ground off the pace throughout and was not a threat. WELCOME HOME RYAN chased between horses and steadied off heels a half mile out, came out into the stretch and did not rally.
