E DUBAI hopped a bit and bumped his entymate at the start, quickly went up between horses to vie for command, inched away on the turn and proved best under a crack of the whip and good handling. GLORIOUS BID had good early speed and dueled three deep between horses to the turn, continued just off the inside stalking the winner leaving the bend and was clearly second best. BROADWAY MOON forced the pace four wide to the turn, continued outside the runner-up on the turn and weakened but held third. ZAHOOM bumped with the winner at the start, settled between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, split rivals into the stretch and made a late run at third. FLYING BADGER close up five wide early, stalked the leaders off the rail, was climbing into the turn and weakened. FIRE FIGHTER unhurried three deep on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, failed to menace. BRAZEN FALSTAFF steadied slightly in a bit of an awkward start, saved ground off the pace, came out a bit on the turn and was never a threat. SKIP TO THE STONE dueled for the lead along the inside on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and had little left.
