With \$60,000 with an additional \$45,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for cup nominees only. The Host Associations money divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Breeders' Cup Fund money also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an award position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund money not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Weights: Three Year Olds 116 lbs. Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 since December 27th, allowed 2 lbs., \$45,000 since November 27th, allowed 4 lbs, \$30,000 since then allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) This race will not be divided. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. Preference given to Breeders' Cup nominees. In no case shall two horses sharing common ownership start to the exclusion of a single interest. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, March 13, 2010, with 11 nominations.
