SILVER MEDALLION checked early off COMMA TO THE TOP and JAKESAM then settled nicely while two wide to the backstretch, moved closer into the second turn, circled the leaders to the stretch, appeared to brush with COMMA TO THE TOP in the upper stretch but recovered, rallied to the lead just past the furlong pole and edged clear driving. JAKESAM set all of the pace from off the rail, was overtaken by the winner leaving the furlong pole but held willingly for the place. POSITIVE RESPONSE raced unhurried early while three wide to the backstretch, commenced his rally from just off the rail into the stretch, loomed a bold factor a furlong out but finished with only a mild late rally. COMMA TO THE TOP broke alertly but bore out to the middle of the track in the opening stages, settled and sat just off JAKESAM to the second turn, moved up into the lane but again drifted out and appeared to brush with the winner and slackened in the final furlong. FORMULA GOLD was never a factor. BLUEGRASS REWARD saved ground to no avail.
