LOCKFORD was unhurried for a half, commenced to rally when roused nearing the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch then finished determinedly and was along in time. WARREN'S PEPE set a pressured pace to the second turn, responded to urging and maintained the advantage to deep stretch then could not hold the winner. ZAPPA tracked the pace to the half, got fanned four wide while advancing on the second turn, loomed to mid stretch but could not get to the top two late. DANCE CHIEF was settled for a half, raced three wide to the stretch and was finishing with interest late. SKIMASCO prompted the pace for six furlongs but tired in the final furlong. MAIDENS JUSTICE stalked the pace to the second turn while saving ground but also tired in the stretch. DOWNSIZED had no speed and was outrun.
