DANCE CHIEF took back into the first turn and raced in the two path to the second turn, commenced his bid three wide on the second turn, rallied steadily from the outside in the lane and was up late to win driving. DEACON SPEAKIN' stalked the leaders three wide to the stretch, rallied to the lead at the furlong pole but was collared late. SILENT SALUTE raced unhurried early and saved ground to the stretch, shifted out and was gaining late. JOE CARL was void of any early speed, raced just off the rail to the stretch then closed too late. BUCK'S BRO pressed the pace two wide into the stretch and came up empty. LANG FIELD dueled from the inside to the stretch and gave out.
