NSYNC LYNX raced up outside ROMAN ACCOUNT into the first turn to take a short lead in the opening quarter, settled nicely once on the backstretch and edged clear, turned back a minor bid from TRAININTHEINFLUNCE at the three eighths pole, was again clear in the upper stretch and held driving. WILD AND READY was not asked for speed in the opening half, commenced his bid on the second turn, split foes three wide into the lane and rallied steadily but could not reach the winner. SWEETVILLE tracked the leaders from the rail early, raced between horses on the second turn, angled three wide into the lane, loomed a factor in the upper stretch but flattened out late. TRAININTHEINFLUNCE was always forwardly placed and came off the rail on the first turn, offered a menacing bid outside the winner on the second turn but slackened in the final quarter. DOWN BY THE LAKE raced unhurried from the rail early, but did not respond while two wide and within striking distance into the lane. DANCE CHIEF was forwardly placed three wide on the first turn, remained a factor to the second turn but was fanned four wide and had no response. ROMAN ACCOUNT dueled early with the winner from the rail but was through after six furlongs. BILLY CASH raced four wide while well back on the first turn and never reached contention.
