OUR NAUTIQUE (NZ) broke alertly and set all the pace to the stretch, responded to strong urging in the drive and held gamely. HUDSON LANDING was allowed to settle for a half mile, bid two then three wide to the stretch and finished willingly late. SLEW THE MAN was rated patiently to the second turn, responded when roused from the rail to the stretch then also finished well. TAIF pressed the pace to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch, stayed on to the wire but was outfinished late. HOT CHACO had no speed and settled, tried to rally while three wide to the stretch then was gaining late without being a threat. DANCE CHIEF was allowed to settle to the second turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch then weakened in the drive.
