EL PADRINO stalked the pace, was caught in tight on the far turn, angled out for the stretch, then rallied to take over late and drew clear. TAKE CHARGE INDY pressed the pace outside BARTOLOME, took over from that rival on the far turn and opened a clear lead but couldn't match strides with the winner late. ARGENTINE TANGO unhurried early, passed tired rivals for the show. BIG SCREEN bumped with A BOY NAMED EM at the start, tracked the pace four wide into the far turn and tired. A BOY NAMED EM bumped and squeezed back from between rivals at the start, was through after a half mile. IN THE BEAT was done early. BARTOLOME set the pace along the rail to the far turn and faltered. CASUAL TRICK stumbled at the start, stalked the pace three wide into the far turn, then faded. GAELICO rated off the pace after bumping with A BOY NAMED EM at the start, stopped racing into the far turn and was pulled up.
