**Footnotes**

TAKEN BY THE STORM stalked the pace four wide, moved up to engage HANSEL TAZWELL entering the stretch, then wore that rival down to prevail. HANSEL TAZWELL set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged by TAKEN BY THE STORM in the stretch, then gave way grudgingly. BERNIE THE JET chased the pace three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. PYRITE MOUNTAIN unhurried early, checked to avoid the stopping ARCHER HILL on the far turn, swung wide for the stretch run and finished full of run. FREDERICKSBURG well placed into the stretch, lacked a late response. CRAVING CARATS tracked the pace along the inside, then steadied in traffic on the far turn and gave way. KID LIGHTNING bumped with ARCHER HILL at the start, then was saving ground when checked on the far turn and never threatened. MR D'ORO was tracking the leaders when checked in behind rivals leaving the far turn and failed to recover. BOLD DANCE bumped on the first turn, raced four wide and was not a factor. ARCHER HILL bumped with KID LIGHTNING at the start, was very rank early, came out bumping BOLD DANCE on the first turn, rushed up along the backstretch to gain a brief lead, then was fading when steadied leaving the far turn.
