Footnotes

SIR SHACKLETON vied for the lead along the inside, edged away in the stretch, then drifted out nearing the sixteenth pole and was fully extended to prevail. WILLY O'THE VALLEY reserved early, advanced into contention four wide around the turn, was steadied in behind SIR SHACKLETON nearing the sixteenth pole, then couldn't get to that rival while clearly second best. SALUTE THE TROOPS vied for the lead outside SIR SHACKLETON into the stretch, then gave way. KENTON well placed while saving ground into the stretch, tired. CONSERVATIONIST off slowly, failed to threaten. GUY GETAWAY was no factor after being outrun early. STARS OF SILVER failed to menace. TITANIUS raced with the pace four wide to past midway of the turn and faltered. OUTER MARKER was outrun while racing three wide. AMERICAN CHEROKEE vied for the lead three wide into the turn and faded. GOTTA HAVE MAGIC saved ground and was done early. The rider of WILLY O'THE VALLEY lodged an objection against the rider of SIR SHACKLETON for alleged interference in the stretch. The claim of foul was not allowed.
