### Footnotes

YANKEE STATION squeezed back at the start, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead past the sixteenth marker and pulled clear. SPEIGHT THE HALO broke outward, sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, continued clear past midstretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. J P JAMMER angled in and stalked inside, came out into the stretch and bested the others. SHEDIK (FR) chased outside then alongside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. UKIAH settled inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. INDY RIDE stalked between horses then outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail into the stretch and weakened. DANCE CHIEF chased just off the inside then along the rail, remained inside in the stretch and did not rally. REMUS broke a bit slowly, settled just off the fence to the stretch and failed to menace. THRUST racing without a whip, was four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep, dropped back on the backstretch and second turn, angled in some and gave way.
