By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination: \$1,000 to enter and start with \$100,000 added of which 62% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth Weight, 122 lbs. Non-winners of Graded stakes on the turf since October 1 allowed 3 lbs. \$45,000 twice on the turf since August 1, 5 lbs. \$30,000 twice on the turf since July 1, 8 lbs. In the event that more than ten fillies and mares pass the entry box, the ten starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, the highest turf earnings in 1998-99. PLEASANT TEMPER, outrun early off the inside, was angled out four wide when rallying with three furlongs to go, made a bold bid approaching the stretch, gained a short lead with a furlongs to go and slowly drew clear. MINGLING GLANCES, within striking distance, pulled in traffic on the backstretch, steadied when boxed in on the second turn, was angled out a bit for the drive and rallied willingly late. RED CAT vied for the lead inside and held on gamely in the drive. SWEARINGEN, behind the leaders along the inside, weakened in the final quarter. WITCHFUL THINKING forced the pace off the inside, stayed well to upper stretch and tired. CUANDO, within striking distance off the inside, raced three wide with three furlongs to go and gave way in the stretch. SHIRES ENDE, three wide on the first turn when unhurried, raced four wide on the second turn and was no threat. COMPASSIONATE, unhurried early, was no factor.
