PANTS ON FIRE moved to the front along the inside on the final turn, showed the way to the lane and drove clear under pressure. HYMN BOOK near the inside into the far turn, was in the three path turning for home, drifted some in midstretch then earned the place. PONZI SCHEME outside into the clubhouse turn, bid three wide on the final bend and chased then needed more. NORMAN ASBJORNSON moved outward into the far turn avoiding an injured rival, came wide to the stretch and lacked a rally. SMALL TOWN TALK saved ground and lacked a bid. BIG SUR pressed early outside then tracked, was angled out some avoiding an injured rival heading into the far turn and inherited the lead briefly between calls, was just off the inside and tired through the lane. TAKE CHARGE INDY saved ground and drew clear on the clubhouse turn, raced just off the rail and edged away some on the backstretch then was pulled up nearing the far turn while racing in unsound fashion and vanned off. The stewards posted the inquiry sign prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
