SOARING EMPIRE bobbled slightly at the start then unhurried early, advanced outside on the final turn, raced four wide into the stretch and battled for command then proved best to the wire. KENSEI up close early outside, pulled in the run down the backstretch, moved closer three wide on the final turn, responded gamely in the drive then could not quite match strides late with the top one. CACTUS CHARLIE never far back and near the inside, pulled in the run down the backstretch, continued just off the rail to the lane and finished willingly while earning the show. MOTOVATO between rivals early, prompted the issue, raced between foes on the final turn and battled for the lead, was along the inside through the lane and yielded in the drive. SOUTHERN RIDGE vied early then rated inside, moved out on the final turn and lacked the needed response. HERMOSILLO three wide into the clubhouse turn, reached the front and drew clear between calls into the backstretch, saved ground and vied to the lane then gradually gave way.
