RYDILLUC was well rated early, raced two wide on the second turn, then drew off while under strong encouragement and held well. CHARMING KITTEN was close up from the start, raced along the two path through the second turn, then rallied late and finished second best. JACK MILTON was never far back, raced three wide on the far turn, then made a good closing effort. PITCH N ROLL was close up early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then finished evenly. NOBLE TUNE was unhurried early, raced along the two path on the far turn, then made a mild bid late. ARE YOU KIDDING ME was void of early speed, saved ground on the second turn, then made a mild gain late. TRIPLE CROSS lacked speed, raced along the two path on the last turn, then passed one late. YOGOTTHATGOINFORU set the early pace with a clear lead, saved ground on the second turn then was headed and faltered in the drive.
