ICABAD CRANE , unhurried early, raced in the two path between horses on the far turn, bumped and carried out FAST TALKING when angled to the three path in upper stretch, challenged for the lead approaching the eighth pole, dueled and narrowly prevailed under brisk urging. MINT LANE , clear entering the first turn, set the pace along the and dueled with the winner the final furlong in a sharp effort. DEPUTYVILLE saved ground while unhurried early, swung out in midstretch and finished willingly. WONDER MON lacked speed, was taken to the five path approaching the stretch and rallied. FAST TALKING , rank behind MINT LANE on the first turn, angled off the rail midway on the far turn, was bumped and floated out in upper stretch then weakened. REGAL SOLO , unhurried early, raced wide around the far turn and failed to rally. CAVE'S VALLEY , three wide down the backstretch, chased the pace and gave way entering the stretch. INDIAN JUMP , a bit fractious in the starting gate, prompted the pace two wide and faltered entering the stretch.
