SQUALLCREEK stalked the pace to the second turn, offered a bid inside then shifted outside of THISCATSGOTCHARM, was being outrun by that one to mid stretch then inherited the lead when that one hit the rail and raced clear to the line. DANCE CHIEF was allowed to settle, rallied four wide on the second turn then could not make a late impact. OVERLAND hesitated and broke slowly, lagged to the second turn, advanced three wide to the stretch then did not threaten the top two. VALID PORT stalked the pace to the half, tried to rally two wide to the stretch but weakened through the drive. GRAND ATLANTIC was a bit reluctant to load then was fractious in the gate, settled to the half, also attempted to rally from the two path on the second turn, was not making any headway then had to swerve away from the fallen rider in deep stretch and was not asked late. SUMMER HAZE stumbled at the break, chased the pace to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch but gave out in the drive. THISCATSGOTCHARM set the pace while racing off the rail to the second turn, responded to steady urging to mid stretch then suddenly ducked inward and attempted to jump the rail nearing the sixteenth pole and lost his rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident but did not alter the results.
