TRAFFIC LIGHT vied for command two wide, resisted when challenged but then was no match late. TEETH OF THE DOG vied for command inside and then faded through the drive. TEETH OF THE DOG sustained a severe laceration behind and was vanned off the race track. JUNEBUGRED was outrun early racing outside, passed tiring foes. MY ADONIS moved up between foes, challenged briefly and then gave way. BRIMSTONE ISLAND raced out from the rail and failed to menace. RUNNIN BULL saved ground just off the pace and tired badly.
