Non-winners of an unrestricted stakes at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 3 lbs; of \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2011, 5 lbs; of \$30,000 at any distance in 2011, 9 lbs. (Maiden, claiming or starter races not considered.) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations closed Saturday, September 3, 2011 with 21. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

STORMY LORD rated three wide off the pacesetters, bid strongly into the stretch and edged clear under steady handling. CITRUS KID prompted the pace, loomed boldly into the lane but was outfinished while gamely holding the place. LUBASH set a measured pace inside to the stretch and held on with determination. BIM BAM advanced between rivals into the far turn, steadied midway on the turn then closed well too late. FEELS ALL RIGHT (IRE) chased four wide, moved closer on the final turn then weakened. AFLEET AGAIN angled outside and trailed early then lacked a solid rally while passing faltering rivals. CAT PARK saved ground while well back and never menaced. SMART BID was just off the pace under rating inside, weakened on the final turn then gave way through the stretch. VIOLON SACRE advanced in the two path, was taken up sharply on the final turn and faded. THE COGNAC KID was allowed to settle well behind and was always outrun.
