ALPHA AND OMEGA broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear through the turn, widen the margin at the eighth pole and was well clear while never asked. TOP NOTCH SLEW chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, made a bid along the rail and was just up for the place. IBAKA forced the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but was outfinished for the place. INDUCTION pressed the early pace from the inside, responded and finished well. DARING ARTAX chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. WILLS POINT was no factor. TENSPEED had a steady fade. THRIFTY was never close. Z HITCHCOCK showed little.
