Footnotes

MASTER APPEAL went around the first turn off the rail, chased off the rail down the backstretch, moved closer three deep around the second turn, came into the stretch four wide, rallied in the middle of the track in the final furlong and wore down the pacesetter in the late going. MORENO was sent along to make the early lead, crossed over into the first turn, set the pace on the inside, drifted out through the lane, could not hold off the winner but was clearly second best. AIRFOIL pulled into the first turn, stalked on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground around the second turn, remained on the wood through the drive and gained the show. SMOKIN' BERNIE pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch and around the second turn, came into the stretch between horses, angled inside the pacesetter in the lane and weakened in the final furlong. IRISH SURF pulled between horses and steadied into the first turn, stalked between foes on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and weakened in the drive. DEL MAR SUNSET went into the first turn three deep, stalked three wide down the backstretch, came into the lane three wide and weakened in the final furlong. DEAD EASY bobbled after the start, saved some ground around the first turn, angled outside on the backstretch, remained well off the rail and did not threaten.
