Footnotes

HIGH CHAPARRAL (IRE) stalked between horses then along the inside, split rivals into the second turn, came out into the stretch and rallied gamely while between foes late under urging to share the win. JOHAR unhurried and angled in a bit off the rail early, moved up outside on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and closed willingly three deep on the line. FALBRAV (IRE) stalked three deep or outside a rival, bid outside the leader leaving the second turn, took a short advantage into the stretch, inched away past midstretch and held on gamely inside the top pair but was edged late. THE TIN MAN prompted the pace outside a rival, took command on the second turn, angled in, fought back inside in midstretch but weakened. SULAMANI (IRE) squeezed a bit in the opening strides, chased between horses, was in tight and clipped heels into the clubhouse turn, chased outside on the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRIGHT SKY (IRE) pulled along the inside early, was in tight between horses into the first turn, chased between foes, split rivals into the second turn, continued toward the inside and weakened. STORMING HOME (GB) squeezed a bit in the early stages, was

in a good position chasing three and four wide to the stretch and lacked the necessary response. TOCET pulled a bit early, raced close up stalking the pace inside, dropped back on the backstretch, came outside a rival into the stretch and gave way. BALTO STAR took the early lead and set a pressured pace inside, steadied while dropping back into the second turn and also gave way. Rail at zero on hill.
