Footnotes

MR. COMMONS three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival or just off the rail, was in close off heels then angled in and surged between foes in midstretch, gained the lead just past the eighth pole and drew off inside under a moderate hand ride and a long hold late. IRISH ART angled in and chased inside then off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep past the quarter pole and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some and outfinished ULTIMATE EAGLE late for the place. ULTIMATE EAGLE angled in and pulled his way along outside a rival early, drifted out into the first turn, angled in again and stalked a bit off the rail or inside, came out leaving the second turn, bid alongside the pacesetter in upper stretch, held a slim lead three deep in midstretch, could not match the winner and was edged late for second. COZY KITTEN dropped back along the inside without early speed, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and improved position. VENOMOUS (GB) pulled his way between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside, split rivals leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. COMMA TO THE TOP sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, shook off a bid leaving the backstretch to kick clear on the second turn, fought back along the rail in midstretch, then weakened. RIVETING REASON pulled three deep early then was fanned four wide into the first turn, moved up outside on the backstretch, bid alongside COMMA TO THE TOP to duel for the lead, fell back some and angled in on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. MOMENT OF WEAKNESS (IRE) between foes early, was fanned three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
