BOLD CHIEFTAIN broke alertly and stalked OUR PARTNER early from the outside, gained command on the second turn, drifted to the four path entering the lane but was straightened and responded once set down to draw off and won driving. AUTISM AWARENESS stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs, cut inside BOLD CHIEFTAN when that one drifted into the stretch, remained a factor to the furlong pole then proved no match. CAPTAIN ROY raced unhurried early, commenced his bid on the second turn, was floated five wide by the winner into the lane, loomed boldly at the head of the lane but flattened out in the drive. OUR PARTNER set the pace from the inside to the second turn and gave way. DANCE CHIEF saved ground throughout but was never a factor.
