FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$3,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$6,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the close of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,500 rebate. Any filly that competes in both the Prioress and the Test will have their entry fee waived for the Test. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 in 2013, 4 lbs.; two races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter, restricted and restricted stake races not considered in allowances). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, July 13, 2013 with 25 Nominations.

LIGHTHOUSE BAY settled off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside, cut the corner into the stretch, rallied near the rail, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker under left-hand urging, drifted out some near the sixteenth-pole, was switched to a right-handed whip and prevailed under good handling. WILDCAT LILY was asked from the start, disputed the pace on the inside of SO MANY WAYS while off the rail, vied three then two wide on the turn, turned into the stretch a length in front, responded well when asked for her best, lost the lead inside the furlong marker, fought on determinedly under a right-handed whip but missed. IRISH LUTE dropped back after the start, settled on the inside, came off the rail near the three-eighths pole, shifted three wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths, angled five wide at the quarter-pole, advanced outside in upper stretch, loomed a threat into the final furlong but flattened out and settled for the show. SO MANY WAYS contested the pace on the outside through sensible fractions, vied in the four path on the turn, moved to the three path into the stretch, dropped back under a drive and tired. LITTLE ROCKET broke out and bumped with KAUAI KATIE, settled at the rear, was urged along while three wide on the turn, angled five wide at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. KAUAI KATIE was bumped at the start, chased the leading duo on the outside, pursued those rivals while in the five path on the turn, moved to the four path into the stretch, dropped back under a drive and capitulated.
