The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. AWAKINO CAT settled in good position in the two path, swung four wide at the quarter pole then closed steadily to wear down TRUE TO TRADITION in the final sixteenth. TRUE TO TRADITION dueled along the rail, shook loose in upper stretch, led into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. REDEFINED raced in hand early, launched a rally entering the stretch, made a run to threaten in midstretch and held for a share. PERFECT OFFICER checked in traffic on the far turn, raced just off the pace into upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. REBELLION (GB) checked at the start, was outrun for a half, swung six wide and rallied belatedly. OUR FRIEND HARVEY raced in the middle of the pack, lodged a four wide move to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. DUFFY'S TAVERN saved ground just off the pace, waited on the turn then faltered. INDIAN ASHTON dueled heads apart from outside for a half and gave way.
