INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD FOALED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to entry. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Turf weights. Non-winners of \$60,000 on the turf in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstake on the turf in 2012, 5 lbs.; three races on the turf, 7 lbs. Dirt Weights: Non-winners of a sweepstake on the dirt in 2011-12 allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 on the dirt in 2011-12 or four races on the dirt, 5 lbs.; three races on the dirt, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track where dirt allowance weights will apply. Closed Saturday, August 4, 2012 with 19 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements. (S)

LUBASH was taken back under a strong hold while fighting the bit, dropped to the inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear while rating more kindly but still under restraint, went three wide early on the far turn, was asked then driven four wide outside the five-sixteenths pole, rallied quickly on the outside, swept to the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, edged clear just inside that marker and proved best under good handling. MINNIE PUNT bumped lightly with the hindquarters of MAJESTIC RAFFY early, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled outside on the backstretch, was roused while three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly to just get the place. COMPLIANCE OFFICER went three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace while on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn, was asked approaching the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick for victory but finished willingly to just miss the place. MAJESTIC RAFFY was bumped lightly in the hindquarters early, saved ground on the first turn, settled near the inside, was urged along while inside on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, moved out in the vicinity of that pole and lacked the needed kick but also finished willingly. STREET GAME went four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the pacesetter on the outside, drew even on the far turn, gained a short lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a left-handed whip after straightening for the drive, lost the lead to the winner, switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and weakened. ABILIO was asked from the start, raced near the inside on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, came under urging while near the inside on the far turn, was put to the whip outside the quarter-pole, moved out towards the back in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. JOHANNESBURG SMILE set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, dropped out in upper stretch and gave way.
