COMPLIANCE OFFICER was rated on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, took the lead outside the eighth-pole, powered clear under left hand urging then proved best under a brisk hand ride late. KARAKORUM LEGEND was rated on the inside, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, moved off the rail at the top of the stretch, was put to repeated left hand urging, moved out near the furlong marker and finished willingly while second best. POCKET COWBOYS was last away then taken in hand, pulled in the early going, raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response while up for the show. LUBASH went to the early lead on his own power, was allowed to set an easy pace while on the inside, came under pressure near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened. WRITINGONTHEWALL allowed LUBASH to set the pace, tracked that rival on the outside while in hand, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled between rivals into the final furlong and tired. GIMME CREDIT was eased back in the early going, raced on the inside while eager and into the bit, continued under restraint on the backstretch, moved off the inside with a half-mile to run, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and failed to rally. ICABAD CRANE moved in after the start, was reserved at the back while on the outside, bided his time on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, raced between rivals in the final furlong, was caught behind horses late and also failed to rally. UNCLE T SEVEN moved in after the start, was reserved while on the inside, bided his time on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, came under a drive, was caught behind horses late and again failed to rally. (Rail at 18 Feet)
