VALID VIDEO settled in good position along the backstretch, steadily gained while saving ground on the turn, closed the gap in upper stretch, steadied along the rail then altered course to the outside in midstretch, finished determinedly to get up in the final strides. GREAT NOTION rushed up along the rail after breaking a bit slowly, set a rapid pace for a half, extended his lead in upper stretch, fought gamely into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. GHOSTZAPPER dropped back while racing well off the rail along the backstretch, launched a rally from outside on the turn, circled six wide into the stretch then finished fastest in the middle of the track but could not get up. DURING pressed the pace while three wide to the top of the stretch, battled into midstretch then weakened under pressure in the final eighth. POSSE lagged far behind along the backstretch, closed the gap between horses while five wide at the top of the stretch then rallied belatedly while racing erratically through the lane. EYE OF THE TIGER was outrun for a half, advanced four wide between horses entering the stretch then failed to threaten while improving his position. CHRISTINE'S OUTLAW stalked three wide for a half and tired. ZAVATA was taken in hand in the early stages, raced just off the pace while five wide to the turn then lacked the needed response when called upon. PRIVATE CITY outrun for a half, circled seven wide on the turn then lugged in while tiring in upper stretch. SCRIMSHAW bumped at the start, was never a factor. MIDNIGHT CHARLIE was outrun while racing wide. HALO HOMEWRECKER, bumped at the start, saved ground to no avail. AWESOME TIME showed only brief speed.
