VISIONAIRE devoid of early foot, unleashed a four wide sweep from midway on the turn, took off after entering the stretch and rolled home for a convincing victory. DESERT KEY well placed along the inside, came home with good courage for the place. I'M SO LUCKY within striking distance finished willingly during the stretch drive. LANTANA MOB unhurried for the opening half, bumped with SALUTE THE SARGE at the three-sixteenths pole. KODIAK KOWBOY saved ground, swung wide approaching the top of the stretch, was bumped in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, altered course and had a mild rally. J BE K battled for the lead while travelling in the three path, fought his way to a clear advantage at the eighth pole, had nothing to offer at that point. SALUTE THE SARGE underwent a four wide journey, was bounced around while exchanging bumps with a pair of foes in upper stretch and failed to threaten thereafter. SILVER EDITION was no factor. GENTLEMAN JAMES vied for the lead along the rail until upper stretch and gave way. GOLDEN SPIKES argued the pace between rivals for a rivals before folding.
