Footnotes

POINT GIVEN broke a bit slowly but raced close up while three wide, advanced three wide leaving the backstretch, responded when set down for the drive, drew clear from E DUBAI inside the eighth pole and was clear under the wire, driving. E DUBAI raced with the pace from the outside while in hand, took over from pacesetter FREE OF LOVE entering the second turn, responded when joined from the outside by the winner turning for home and dug in gamely but could not stay with that rival in the final furlong. DOLLAR BILL was unhurried outside early on, was put to the whip nearing the second turn, advanced wide approaching the stretch and stayed on stubbornly to the finish. A P VALENTINE raced close up inside, was roused on the backstretch, angled out and came wide approaching the stretch and stayed on well. FREE OF LOVE quickly showed in front, set the pace for three quarters and faded along the inside. SCORPION chased the pace while between rivals, had no response when roused and tired in the stretch. VOLPONI came away a step slowly, was rated along early, raced wide and had no response when roused. HADRIAN'S WALL dropped back early, raced inside and had no response when roused. HARRISAND (FR) was rated inside, had no response when put to the whip on the backstretch and tired.
