SQUIRTLE SQUIRT quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand, drew clear when roused and remained clear under a drive. ILLUSIONED was outrun early, came wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. CITY ZIP was steadied when in tight quarters on the backstretch, put in a three wide run approaching the stretch and tired in the drive. BAY HEAD KING was in tight quarters on the backstretch, chased the pace and tired in the stretch. SHORE BREEZE was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. KEATS chased the pace from the outside and tired after a half mile. ORIENTATE was in tight quarters on the backstretch, chased inside and tired in the stretch. THE GOO was in tight quarters on the backstretch, chased the pace and tired.
