FORESTRY flashed good speed from the start, joined FIVE STAR DAY from the outside on the turn and bested that rival after a hard drive. FIVE STAR DAY, off slowly and bumped at the start, was rushed to the front, set a strong pace and battled gamely on the rail but could not hold off the winner. SUCCESSFUL APPEAL chased the pace and finished gamely. VICAR, outrun early, put in a four wide run on the turn but lacked a solid finishing punch. DONERAILE COURT put in a run along the inside on the turn but could not sustain that bid. SILVER SEASON, hustled outside, raced wide and lacked a rally. ARISTOTLE tired after an inside trip. TORRID SAND was outrun. LIMESTONE, bumped at the start, had no rally. LION HEARTED had no response when roused. FETCH DINNER stopped after showing brief speed. YES IT'S TRUE chased the pace and tired badly in the stretch.
