Any horse that competes in both the Amsterdam and the NetJets King's Bishop will have their entry fee waived for this race. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2009; or a Grade 2 twice in 2009 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 1 or Grade 2, 4 lbs.; A sweepstake, or three races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted allowance races not considered). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. VINEYARD HAVEN rushed up along the rail, dueled inside his entymate for a half, shook loose in midstretch, drifted out under left hand whipping bumping twice with CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN in deep stretch and prevailed after a hard drive. Following a Stewards' inquiry VINEYARD HAVEN was disqualified from first and placed second for interference in deep stretch. CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN was reserved for a half, moved out midway on the turn, swung five wide at the quarter pole, made a strong move to threaten inside the furlong marker, was bumped off stride in deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. MUNNINGS settled in good position for a half, waited patiently while saving ground on the turn, made a run along the rail to threaten in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid. DESPITE THE ODDS stumbled at the start, moved up inside, steadied in traffic between horses nearing the quarter pole and lacked a strong closing response. NOT FOR SILVER failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. BIG DRAMA pressed four wide along the backstretch, raced just off the pace into upper stretch and gradually tired thereafter. FLAT BOLD trailed after breaking slowly, circled six wide and lacked a late response. EVERYDAY HEROES dueled between horses for five furlongs and gave way. PRINCE JOSHUA dueled early between horses and gave way abruptly on the turn.
