### Footnotes

HOOH WHY was unhurried early, made a middle move to be in striking distance into the stretch, swung five wide then closed stoutly to be up in the final strides. INAUGURATE was close up early, waited for racing room through the second turn and into the stretch then split rivals to challenge in the furlong grounds and gain a short lead late only to be caught on the wire. SWEET LITTLE LION raced well placed, bid four wide into the furlong grounds then was outkicked late. AWESOME BELLE led into the final furlong then weakened. SCENARIO ANALYSIS was well placed inside but had no rally. MILLENNIA failed to menace. ARSENAL was no factor. LAVALLEE TWIST chased early, gained a short lead in the second turn then came up empty. ANOTHER SMOKEY was no factor. CORRESPONDENT stopped.
