DEMONSTRATIVE placed near midpack took the inside route, was allowed to run on his own power until nearing the final turn, picked up interest and slowly moved into contention, reached the tenth jump the innermost member of a threesome only heads apart, shook free during the short run leading up to the final fence, went over it well and drew off. ONE GIANT STEP devoid of early speed, brought up the back of the pack for much of the running, made a three wide run around the final turn to reach contention, jumped over the stricken rival after completing the next to last jump, rallied with good courage in the late stages to secure second. ALL TOGETHER well placed, saved ground, moved outward a bit in preparation for the stretch drive, bid in earnest coming to the tenth jump, but could not sustain the move. CALL YOU IN TEN off the inside, bobbled going over the tenth jump, then was steadied to avoid the fallen rival shortly thereafter. COMPLETE ZEN had a wide journey and tired. LAKE PLACID vied for the lead and faltered. BALLETT BOY (IRE) raced along the outside and was outrun. SLANEY ROCK (IRE) forwardly placed from the start, fell over the tenth. GOOD REQUEST left the course after going over the sixth.
