Footnotes

GREEK SUN settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, moved up inside on the second turn, came out three deep into the stretch and rallied under some left handed urging to sweep to the front past midstretch and won clear. VIKINGS BAY (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and gained the place late three deep. GWAIHIR (IRE) pulled his way between horses early, stalked toward the inside, bid between rivals into and on the second turn and into the stretch and narrowly edged a foe for third. ATTEN HUT also pulled under a hold early and steadied in tight on the first turn, came off the rail on the backstretch, bid three deep into and on the second turn, gained a short lead in upper stretch, was no match for the winner in the final furlong but gave ground grudgingly to the others. LINDERO a bit crowded at the start, pulled outside rivals early, stalked alongside a foe then off the rail leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. PIONEERMAN pulled his way to the front and angled in, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail into and on the second turn and into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong.
