FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 each at time of closing. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% of the added monies to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three year olds, 118 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes since November 5, allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 in 2011, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming since October 31, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 21, 2011 with 23 nominations.

NOBLE'S PROMISE tracked the pace in hand, ranged up four wide through the turn, collared ATTA BOY ROY with a furlong to run, shook off that one and gradually edged clear. ATTA BOY ROY disputed the pace three wide, opened clear leaving the turn, dug in gamely to meet the challenge of NOBLE'S PROMISE but grudgingly gave in late. CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN was away a step slow, ranged into striking distance four wide, angled out entering the stretch and loomed a danger but failed to sustain the drive. GOOD LORD hopped at the start, was unhurried into stride, circled five wide and improved position. RILEY TUCKER broke slow, tucked in to save ground, shifted out entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally. HERE COMES BEN was slow into stride, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. HURRICANE IKE attended the pace off of the inside, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. CASH REFUND dueled for the lead along the inside for a half and stopped.
