Footnotes

HATTIESBURG unhurried early, swung to the outside for the stretch run, then rallied under pressure to catch SOUTHERN TOUR at the seventy yard pole and prevailed. SOUTHERN TOUR chased the pace four wide, moved to gain a slim lead nearing the eighth pole but couldn't hold off the winner late. SPANISH GLITTER moved up quickly to set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged leaving the turn, then weakened in the final eighth. LUCETTE outrun early, angled wide in early stretch and closed with a belated rally. CHERYL P. prompted the pace outside SPANISH GLITTER, made a run at that rival leaving the turn and into the stretch, then tired. OUSSTOURA raced four wide around the turn, then lacked a late response. XTREME BID failed to menace. VALID FORBES saved ground and faltered. SILK CONCORDE broke through the gate prior to the start, chased the pace three wide around the turn and gave way. I AM NIFTY showed early foot along the inside, then gave way. MORNING SUN showed nothing.
