

MOP SQUEEZER made the pace along the inside, increased her margin in midstretch and was under steady urging to prevail. BEYOND THE SUN chased the pace while saving ground, angled off the rail for the stretch run and continued on with good courage to prove second best. SEJM'S LUNAR STAR reserved along the inside, outfinished the others. TACTICAL MOVE outrun early, angled out for the stretch run and improved her position. SILVER BANDANA, off slowly, advanced four wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then tired. PEER REVIEW was no factor after breaking slowly. GRAND VERANDA chased the pace three wide and faltered. GITANITA prompted the early pace and faded. LADY BUCKINGHAM was outrun.
