STAKES Colonel E. R. Bradley H. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$125 by Saturday, January 2. \$600 to enter; \$625 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted by 12:00 noon, Thursday, January 7 which shall include all fees. \$125,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10%, to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weights: Thursday, January 7. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. The maximum number of starters for the Colonel E. R. Bradley Handicap will be determined by rail setting. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, January 2, 2016 with 26. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth.)

CHOCOLATE RIDE was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, came off the rail while asked at the quarter-pole, responded well when put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch and held under strong urging. ROMAN APPROVAL went two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace while tugging at the bit, went three then four wide on the far turn, rallied into the final furlong, came between horses at the sixteenth-pole and finished with good energy to garner the place. BLARP raced in the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was asked while two to three wide early on the far turn, shifted to the five path outside the quarter-pole and also finished with good energy while up for the show. FLASHLIGHT (IRE) was rated on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and finished with good courage but was out-kicked. STRING KING saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced inside early on the far turn, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole, came between horses near the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. POTOMAC RIVER went three wide on the first turn, settled at the rear, raced in the two path early on the far turn, moved to the four path outside the quarter-pole and was no factor. SKY FLIGHT went three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the two path on the far turn, pursued the leader under the whip in upper stretch and weakened. HOT ZAPPER went four

then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved up midway down the backstretch, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch then tired. IBAKA went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along in the two path on the far turn and came up empty then was vanned off after the race.
